Re: MLIB Update and Re-Opening Plan

Good day to all:

MLIB Band Offices will be re-opening on May 25, 2020 with strict COVID-19 measures in place as per the advice of the Provincial Health Officer. MLIB Staff will be returning to work with strict guidelines to ensure elders and community members safety is paramount.

Administration will be offering health, education, employment & training as well as housing services within the protocols identified in the MLIB Return to Work Policy.

Here is an important list of MLIB Safety Protocols you should be aware of:

1. All MLIB offices will re-open for appointments only. Band office staff will continue to work behind locked doors. Members can call the Band Office to book appointments.
2. Band staff will adhere to staggered work schedules which will be reviewed every 2-weeks.
3. Staff will work in their office space only and only designated staff will be allowed to deliver services in the community.
4. Staff will be conducting rigorous cleaning of office spaces and reception area at all times.
5. Continue washing your hands often with soap & water or use alcohol-based sanitizers for at least 20 seconds.
6. Everyone will be practising social distancing and keeping 6-feet distance from each other.
7. Avoid gatherings and meetings with more than 15 people – ensure there is enough space to maintain the 6-foot distance.
8. Non-essential travel curtailment is still in effect. Staff are to use video or phone conferencing.
9. Anyone who is sick or has symptoms of being sick will be requested to stay home and to follow the COVID-19 sick protocols if their symptoms are fever, cough and having difficulty breathing.
10. Anyone who appears sick must isolate at home to avoid spreading illness to others.

Thank you all for doing your part in helping to stop the spread of COVID-19. For the time being we have to continue with all measures to keep each other safe. COVID-19 has not gone away as the threat remains. We have done a good job of flattening the curve because of the safety measures that have been implemented, we must continue these practices to avoid a second wave. We hope you are vigilant and taking pre-cautions when you are travelling and going into the city for shopping.

We look forward to returning to the office to provide services under our “new normal”, we appreciate your continued patience and cooperation.
